

YABEC 2025 will be held in Matsue, a historic city in Shimane Prefecture, Japan, renowned as the "City of Water."

November is regarded as a special month in Japanese mythology and is called "神無月" (the month when the gods are absent).

According to ancient Japanese myths, during this time, the gods from various regions of Japan would gather at the Izumo Taisha, considered the central sanctuary of the gods in Shimane Prefecture, to reflect on the events of the past year and hold discussions to plan for the coming year. Thus, in other parts of Japan, November was referred to as "神無月" the "month when the gods are not present."

In essence, Shimane Prefecture, the host of YABEC2025, was seen as the venue for the gods' "convention."
